

**MOLINE FOUNDATION MAKES GRANT TO  
THE FAMILY RESOURCES, INC.  
QC DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER**

**March 5, 2010** – The Moline Foundation has made a grant in the amount of **\$1,300 to the Family Resources, Inc. QC Domestic Violence Shelter** to help underwrite new toys for the shelter’s Children’s Play Therapy Room and the shelter’s spring and summer children’s activities programs.

Family Resources, Inc. opened the QC Domestic Violence Shelter in October of 1992. It continues to serve more than **300 women and children** each year who are fleeing abusive relationships for the safety and security of the Shelter. Approximately two-thirds of the clients served at the shelter are children; the recently established Children’s Play Therapy room is stocked with toys purchased with funds from the Moline Foundation grant. Funds from the grant will also be used to provide spring break and summer school vacation field trips, outings and activities for the children staying at the shelter.
